

## WEE CABIN Carpenter Responsibilities. 2026

- Build timber-frame cabins & other structures.
- Installs walls, floors, ceilings, and roofs using materials such as: wood, steel, metal, concrete, plastics, and composites of multiple materials, including installation of roof ridge cap.
- Fit and install window frames, doors, door frames, door hardware, interior and exterior trim using a carpenter's level, plumb bob, and laser levels.
- Erect scaffolding and ladders for assembling structures above ground levels.
- Shapes or cuts materials to specified measurements, using hand tools, machines, or power saws.
- Follows established safety rules and regulations and maintains a safe and clean environment.
- Builds or repairs as required: cabinets, doors, frameworks, floors, or other wooden fixtures used in buildings, using woodworking machines, hand tools, or power tools.
- Assembles and fastens materials to make frameworks using hand tools and wood screws, nails, dowel pins, or glue.
- Removes damaged or defective parts or sections of structures and repair or replace, using hand tools.
- If installed by Wee Cabin Co., inspect floor tile, wall coverings, siding, glass, or woodwork to detect broken or damaged structures.
- Staining structures, if requested by clients.
- If not subcontracted, employee may be asked to assist with piers & concrete work.
- Moves necessary materials around jobsite as assigned.
- Cleans up worksite debris.
- Employee will be asked to pick up & transport materials to job site. Employee will be paid for this time.

## Carpenter Qualifications / Skills desired:

- Capable of receiving and following instructions and communicating with co-workers.
- Ability to carry out instructions.
- Able to read and adhere to labels, safety warnings, and guidelines
- Attentive to detail and always alert to ensure safety
  
- Basic/Foundational Carpentry skills needed. Advanced skills an asset.
- Must have own vehicle for transportation.
- Attention to detail.
- Must be able to safely lift 120 lbs.
- Ability to comprehend schematic diagrams, blueprints, sketches, building plans and other specifications are an asset.
- Math skills helpful.
- Strong working knowledge of job site safety as well as ability to complete a company specific safety orientation.
- Basic carpentry tools: drill, impact driver, jigsaw, circular saw, speed square. If you do not have these tools, please let your manager know.
- **If you do not know how to do one of these tasks, you will be taught it.**
